FSC offers shotgun (trap, 5 stand, skeet, & sporting clays), rifle (CMP, NRA Silhouette, Rimfire & Long Range sporting events), pistol (Steel Challenge & USPSA), Muzzleloader and an Archery 3-D course and tower. Other scheduled activites include Horseshoes, Darts, Hunter / Trapper Education classes, Adopt a Highway, various firearm & range officer Certifications, Youth activities, along with many other special shooting events and fundraisers though out the year.

This month's FSC Event Spotlight:

FSC MUZZLELOADER / BLACK POWDER SHOOTS

From the invention of gunpowder, the use of black powder muzzleloading firearms has put food on the table, formed a special brotherhood in competition, defended against aggression of opposing forces, and essentially has changed the history of the world, including playing a large part of the liberation and creation of America.

Whether practicing for upcoming hunting seasons or using the muzzleloader for competition purposes, that "brotherhood of the smoke pole" and pioneering spirit remains alive at the FSC Muzzleloader Mondays & Special Black Powder Shoots.

"Muzzleloader Mondays" are conducted in the Archery area, Shooters have a station to load, shoot, and clean at the Pavilion. Several target options are presented at different distances. Each shooter engages the targets offhand and the targets are scored depending on the hits on target. Shooters then move to the next station and target where the course of fire is repeated. All safely operating relic or replica muzzleloading firearms are welcome, due to the spirit of the event and course layout no inlines please. No jacketed bullets or heavy charges. Ear and Eye protection required, 4:30PM start, please come earlier for registration & enjoyment over pleasant conversation.

Muzzleloader / Black Powder Special events are periodically held that differ from Muzzleloader Mondays in the course of fire and have historically have incorporated additional tomahawk throws and other interesting traditional tools. Targets vary from paper life sized game targets, to traditional bullseye targets, to various targets placed at different distances to entertain and challenge the participant.
